For the past several years I have been collecting the History of the HOBLIT FAMILY and with the aid of all the work of Bernice Montgomery, Grace Hoblit Jacobs, Nadine Howe, Edna Richmond, Hannah Easter Dowling, Wilfred C. Hoblit, William Hoblit and David Hoblit along with the many other descendants I have collected an enormous amount of History.

Born in Alsace Lorraine, Germany, came to America about 1750 and settled in Pennsylvania. Married Catherine Van Veigle, daughter of Sebastian Van Veigle, and was a potter by trade. Died in 1795 and buried in Woodford County Kentucky.

Their daughters Catherine and Mary married and remained in Pennsylvania. After the death of Johannes Michael Hoblit, his widow, Catherine, along with the remaining children, moved to American Bottom, (Ohio Valley - Wabash and Pennsylvania Rivers). After one crop they moved to Kentucky, and then to Ohio, "Todds Fork" near Wilmington - about five miles out.

Widow Catherine, (children's mother) married Mr. Cochran. Catherine died near Wilmington, Ohio in 1820.

Operations against Shelby north of the Arkansas River May 13-31, 1864. Action at Clarendon June 25-26. Scouts from Pine Bluff toward Camden and Monticello January 26-31, 1865. Expedition from Little Rock to Mt. Elba January 22 - February 4, 1865.

Mustered out July 12 and discharged at Springfield, Ill., July 24, 1865.

Regiment lost during service 3 Enlisted men killed and mortally wounded and 7 Officers and 188 Enlisted men by disease. Total 198.
